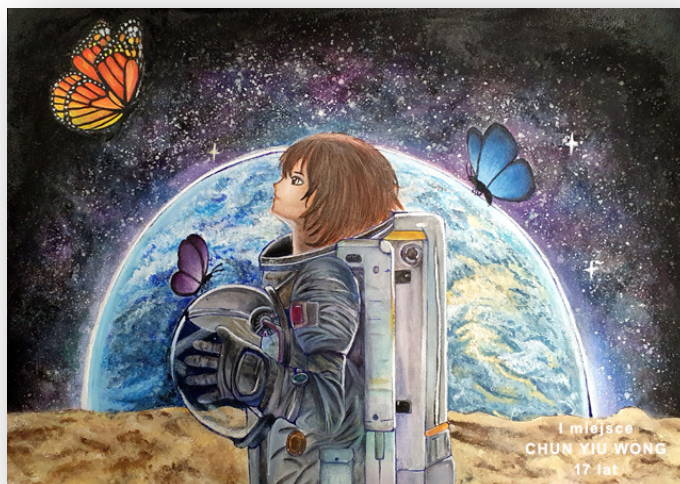

1. Organisers:

2. The objectives of the competition:

- to popularise knowledge of nature and to awaken interest in astronomy,
- raising awareness of the beauty of nature and learning to observe astronomical phenomena,
- shaping imagination and aesthetic sensitivity by popularising a variety of artistic forms,
- developing the creative activity of children and young people
- developing artistic talents,
- showcasing children's artistic creativity.

3. Addresses of the competition:

The competition is aimed at pupils and young people from primary and secondary schools.

The competition will include 4 age categories:

- Grades I-III
- Grades IV-VI
- Grades VII-VIII
- secondary schools,

4. Participation rules:

Participation in the competition is free of charge. The competition is open to artworks or photographic works related to astronomy. Each participant can submit a maximum of 1 work for the competition.

ARTWORK TECHNIQUE AND FORMAT:

Flat works - painting, drawing, graphics (including computer graphics) - format not smaller than 30x40 cm and not larger than 40x60 cm.

Spatial works - any technique - the size of the works must fit in a cube with a side of 40 cm.

All elements of the work should be permanently attached to it, please do not send works made of loose materials.

Photographs only in sizes: 30x30, 30x40, 30x45 cm,

5. Submission of work:

Each work must be described clearly in capital letters according to the formula:

- author's name,
- title of work,
- class and age of the author,
- the name, address and contact details of the school,
- the name and telephone number of the supervisor.

For this purpose, the table in Appendix 1 should be completed and the entire Appendix together with the signed consent to the processing of personal data should be permanently attached to the work.

The competition entries must be sent by 27 October 2023 (date of postage/postmark) to:

Submitted works become the property of the Planetarium of the Faculty of Science, Natural Sciences and Technology of the Jan Długosz University in Częstochowa and may be presented at any place and time. The organisers do not refund the cost of postage.

6. Settlement and conclusion of the competition:

Settlement of the competition will take place by the end of December 2023. The jury competition committee will be made up of the organisers, who have the right to invite artists to the committee visual artists for a more complete evaluation of the submitted works. The organisers have the right to

make a division into age groups of authors and, depending on the level of the works submitted and, depending on the artistic level of the works, award places from I - VIII for each group separately. The Commission may also award a Grand Prix for an outstanding work. The prizes will be distributed by 28 February 2024. Information on the date, place and form of the prize distribution will be communicated to the schools of the winners and posted on the websites:
